NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Notice of Race which may be changed by further notices, the Sailing Instructions and their appendices will apply.
- 1.4 RRS 44.2 will be changed as follows: Two Turns Penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty (one turn in the same direction, including one tack and one gybe).
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 Jury has the right to decide on all other matters.





2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising Category C will apply in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the International 8 Metre and 6 Metre Classes, which have a valid measurement certificate, completed registration and paid the entry fee.

3.2 All entries must be done by e-mail: kristi@kjk.ee or fax +372 62 39 028. Please find and fill entry form on the last page. The entry is not valid until the entry fee has been paid. The entry fee shall be paid directly to the bank account of Kalev Jaht Klubi. Entry closes on Thursday 12 July 2007. Late entries will be accepted subject to 30% additional charge.

4 ENTRY FEE

4.1 The entry fee is:

- a) 8 Metre - 80 EUR
- b) 6 Metre - 60 EUR

5 RACE SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration will take place at the Kalev Yacht Club Race Office as follows: Wednesday 25 July 15-19.00 and Thursday 8.00 – 10.00 26 July 2007. Late registration may be done by notifying the jury boat before start.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available from the Race Office at registration. Jury can decide on the acceptance of incorrect sail numbers and country codes.

7 RACE COURSE

The courses will be sailed windward / leeward configuration with fleet racing. Attachment A1 shows the location of the racing areas.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

9 SCORING

Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- a) When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a yacht's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When five (5) to six (6) races have been completed, a yacht's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 JURY

A Jury shall be appointed in accordance with RRS 90 (a).

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel must stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Jury.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.



15 PRIZES

The first place' prize will be awarded to the boat with the overall lowest score. Prizes will be awarded also to the next two (2) positions.

16 DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta. It is the sole responsibility of each participating boat to have adequate and valid third-party insurance.
